The 10 episodes of #Lovesignal revolve around 10 small acts commonly seen in a relationship. Hayley, played by singer/actor kayan9896, is sparing no effort to break up with her boyfriend Jason, played by singer ANSONBEAN. Ling (Lam Chin-Ting), Hayley's roommate, is encouraged by Hayley to broaden her social circle and meet people. The two girls share the tiniest daily happenings in their respective relationships, learning about the most intimate details in each other's minds while each wishing for the other to find her Mr Right. Other cast members include up-and-coming actors Chan Charm-man, Pak Tin-nam, Ling Man-lung, Aaron Chow and Kaki Sham.

Viu-ers in Hong Kong will be able to watch #Lovesignal exclusively on Viu at noon on 7 October and every Friday and Saturday thereafter. The series will also be available across Viu's markets in Asia. the Middle East and South Africa.
