



HKT x FWD 2023 National Day Fireworks Display

HKT (SEHK: 6823) & FWD Insurance – HONG KONG, 15 September 2023 – HKT Limited (HKT) and FWD Insurance (FWD) are presenting the "HKT x FWD 2023 National Day Fireworks Display" for the enjoyment of the Hong Kong public. Celebrating the 74th anniversary of the founding of the People's Republic of China, this will be the first National Day pyrotechnics show to grace the city's skies since 2018.

The fireworks display, coordinated by the Culture, Sports and Tourism Bureau and cosponsored by HKT and FWD, will take place over Victoria Harbour at 9pm on 1 October 2023 (Sunday).

On top of celebrating the special occasion, the brilliant fireworks convey well wishes of prosperity for businesses and symbolise an even brighter future for the city. With a total of 31,888 firing shells to be discharged from nine locations spanning three barges and six pontoons, the 23-minute show comprises eight scenes (listed in the appendix), among which the "double red hearts" in the first scene, "Bauhinia x blakeana" in the second and "red five-pointed stars" in the sixth are highlights. The multi-colour hydrangea in the fifth scene will make its Hong Kong premiere, erupting into rings, spirals, crowns and other designs after its initial launch to wow spectators. The budget for the entire event is estimated at HK\$18 million.
